

LOCAL RULE — GREENS RESTORATION (SPRIGS)

Areas on the putting greens that contain sprigs planted as part of the greens restoration project are designated as **Ground Under Repair (GUR)** and **No Play Areas**.

You are prohibited from putting from or through these **No Play Areas**. You may not take a stance in any part of the **No Play Area**, even in your ball is not in the **No Play Area**.

Relief from Interference by these areas:

- **Ball in a No Play Area containing Sprigs:**

If a player's ball lies in a **No Play Area** on the putting green, the player must take relief. The ball must be lifted and relief taken without penalty by placing the ball at the nearest spot that avoids interference from the sprig, no closer to the hole.

- **No Play Area containing sprigs in Line of Play:**

If a **No Play Area** intervenes on the player's line of play on the putting green, the player may, without penalty, move the ball to the nearest spot, no closer to the hole, that provides complete relief from the **No Play Area**.

Note: Players must **not** intentionally stand, walk, or putt through the sprigged **No Play Areas**.
